Background

Kent County Council is our Local Highway Authority and as such responsible for the maintenance and safety of public roads. In this capacity it encourages Parish/Town Councils to produce a Highway Improvement Plan ("HIP") to identify and prioritise what local communities see as the main problems on local highways.

KCC Proposal

As part of the current review process and as a result of an instance where an emergency vehicle struggled to turn right into Mill Lane from the Headcorn Road due to cars parked at the junction in contravention of Highway Code Rule 250, KCC are considering the introduction of double yellow lines at the junction on Headcorn Rd, Mill Lane, The Street and Biddenden Road.

Prior to a formal consultation process, KCC have asked Frittenden Parish Council to undertake an informal consultation to gauge local views and opinions. To this end, FPC will hold an open meeting on Thursday 25th July at 7.30 p.m. in the Memorial Hall to set out KCC's proposals, explain their reasoning and to garner local views.
